FAQ

Who is eligible to get the vaccine?

Currently the following groups are eligible for COVID vaccine in Georgia:

- Healthcare workers (physicians, nurses, lab technicians, EMS)
- Law Enforcement
- Fire Personnel
- First Responders
- Residents and staff of long-term care facilities
- Adults 55+
- Individuals 16+ with disabilities and medical conditions such as:
 - ◆ Asthma (moderate to severe)
 - ◆ Cancer
 - ◆ Cerebrovascular disease
 - ◆ Chronic kidney disease
 - ◆ Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease
 - ◆ Cystic Fibrosis
 - ◆ Diabetes
 - ◆ Hypertension or high blood pressure
 - ◆ Heart conditions
 - ◆ Immunocompromised
 - ◆ Liver disease
 - ◆ Neurologic conditions
 - ◆ Overweight and obesity
 - ◆ Pregnancy
 - ◆ Pulmonary fibrosis
 - ◆ Sickle Cell Disease
 - ◆ Thalassemia (blood disorder)
- Educators and staff (Pre-K, K-12, DECAL licensed or exempt childcare programs)
- Adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their caregivers
- Parents of children with complex medical conditions

If you make an appointment and are not included in the above categories, you will be turned away from the site and you will not receive a vaccine.

How do I schedule an appointment?

You can schedule an appointment online at myvaccinegeorgia.com.

Do I need to schedule an appointment?

Yes. GEMA/HS Mass Vaccination Sites will not allow non-registered drive-ups.

Do I have to schedule my appointment online?

No. You can schedule your appointment over-the-phone using the site-specific number listed below.

Can I schedule an appointment at any site?

Yes. Georgia residents can schedule an appointment at any of the sites.

Will the vaccine be free at these locations?

Yes. There will be no out-of-pocket cost to the patient.

What do I need to bring to my appointment?

You will need to show site personnel the **QR code** generated for your appointment. You can have the QR code either on your mobile device or printed out. You will also need **some form of identification.**

Do I need to come back for a second dose?

Yes. You will need to schedule a second appointment within 4 weeks after your initial appointment.

How do I schedule my second dose?

Sharecare will contact you to schedule an appointment within 3 weeks of your initial appointment. You will not have to preregister again for your second appointment.

If I've received my first dose already through the local health department or a private provider, can I schedule my second dose at the site?

No. You should contact the entity you received the first dose from and schedule the second dose with them.

According to the website, there are no more appointments available for this week. When will I be able to schedule an appointment for next week?

If you are preregistered, you **will receive a notification** when more appointments are available.

I'm a healthcare professional and would like to assist at the Mass Vaccinations Sites. Are you accepting volunteers?

At this time, **volunteers are not currently needed** to staff the Mass Vaccination Sites. However, you can register on the State Emergency Registry of Volunteers (SERVGA) site with the Georgia Department of Public Health if you would like to assist with emergency response in the future.
